

Infrachain privacy notice

- **Contact details**

Infrachain a.s.b.l. (« Infrachain », « we », « our ») is established and has its registered office at 5, rue Large, L-1917 Luxembourg. We are registered with the Luxembourg Trade and Companies Register under number F11332. Our e-mail address : info [AT] infrachain [DOT] com

- **How do we get information?**

Most of the personal information we process is provided to us directly by you for one of the following reasons:

- You submit a membership request.
- You are a contact person of one of our members
- You have made an enquiry to us.
- You have made an information request to us.
- You wish to attend, have registered for or have attended, an event.
- You subscribe to our e-newsletter.

- **Legal basis for processing**

The legal basis we rely on to process your personal data are articles 6(1)(a), 6(1)(b) and 6(1)(f) of the GDPR, which allows us to process personal data when its necessary for the purposes of our legitimate interests.

- **Your right of access**

You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal information. We may refuse your subject access request if your data includes information about another individual, except where:

- the other individual has agreed to the disclosure, or
- it is reasonable to provide you with this information without the other individual's consent.

- **Your right to rectification**

You have the right to ask us to rectify information you think is inaccurate. You also have the right to ask us to complete information you think is incomplete. We can refuse to comply with a request for rectification if it believes that the request is what the law calls "manifestly unfounded or excessive". In reaching this decision, it can take into account whether the request is repetitive.

In such circumstances Infrachain can:

- request a reasonable fee to deal with the request, or
- refuse to deal with the request.

In either case we will need to tell you and justify our decision.

- **Your right to erasure**

You have the right to ask us to erase your personal information. Infrachain can refuse to erase your data in the following circumstances:

- When keeping your data is necessary for reasons of freedom of expression and information (this includes journalism and academic, artistic and literary purposes).

- When Infrachain is legally obliged to keep hold of your data.
- When keeping hold of your data is necessary for reasons of public health.
- When keeping your data is necessary for establishing, exercising or defending legal claims.
- When erasing your data would prejudice scientific or historical research, or archiving that is in the public interest.

Infrachain can also refuse your request if it is, as the law states, “manifestly unfounded or excessive”.

If, having considered your request, we decide we do not need to erase your data, we must still respond to you and should explain to you why we believe we do not have to erase your data, and let you know about your right to complain about this decision to the CNPD , or through the courts.

- **Your right to restriction of processing**

You have the right to ask us to restrict the processing of your information.

- **Your right to object to processing**

You have the right to object to processing. However, we remain able to process your information if the process forms part of our public tasks, or is in our legitimate interests.

- **Your right to data portability**

This only applies to information you have given us. You have the right to ask that we transfer the information you gave us to another organization, or give it to you. The right only applies if we are processing information with your consent.

- You are not required to pay any charge for exercising your rights. We have one month to respond to you.

- **Sharing your information**

We will not share your information with any third parties for the purposes of direct marketing.

Infrachain uses services from Dropbox, Eventbrite, GitLab, Google and MailChimp for administration and communication relations. However, these providers have their own privacy policy, which can be found at their respective web sites .

In some circumstances, we are legally obliged to share information. For example under a court order. In any scenario, we'll satisfy ourselves that we have a lawful basis on which to share the information and documents our decision making and satisfy ourselves we have a legal basis on which to share the information.

- **Your right to complain**

If you remain dissatisfied, you can make a complaint about the way we process your personal information to the CNPD.

- **Links on our website**
